Net Returned Surplus Funds Held in Trust by the

ATLANTIC & CAPE MAY COUNTIES ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL BUSINESS OFFICIALS JIF

WHEREAS, the Avalon Board of Education, hereinafter referred to as BOARD, participated as a member district of the Atlantic & Cape May Counties Association of School Business Officials JIF, hereinafter referred to as FUND, for one or more of the FUND fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, 2017 and/or 2018, and

WHEREAS, the FUND is a statutory filed school district joint insurance fund as defined in N.J.S.A. 18A:18B1-10 et seq., and
